"Gautschen" is a retraceable tradition of the guild of book printers. Since the 16th century after passing the final exam the apprentices were ducked in a vat as part of a completion ceremony.

The "Gautschen" in the Gutenberg City Mainz is the world's largest event of this tradition. It is the key event at the Mainzer Johannisnacht (Midsummer), with several thousand spectators watching the ceremony between the Gutenberg Museum and the Dome every year. Since 2014 an honorary letter will be awarded to personalities who have made a special contribution toward the cause of graphic trade or media sector.

Visit the Mainzer Johannisnacht 2015 on June 19th – 22th. Four days of music, theater, folk groups, book market and artists' market in the city of Mainz.
